Reducing sugar, fat and salt, The Parliament rejects the allegations

On February 2, 2012 Euro-MP rejected the proposal allowing the food industry to sell products with indications on reducing sugar, fat or salt.

Through this decision the European consumers will not see flourishing on food packaging mentions like "contains 15% less fat", "20% reduction of salt", etc..

If this measure had been approved a new food category, similar to that of low-fat products have been created.
