The meeting focused on the activities of WP5 and WP6 respectively "Definition and exchange of good practices" and "Follow-up of the food reformulation".

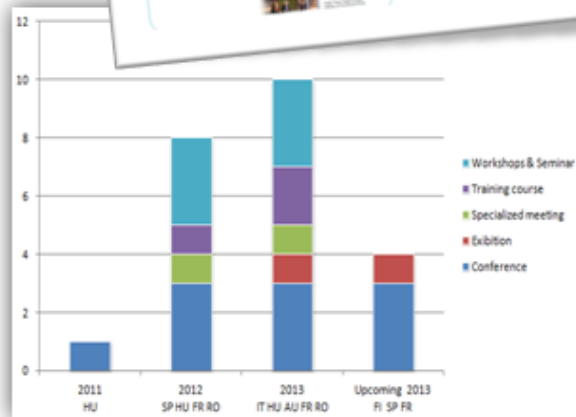
For WP6 it was considered preferable to extend the duration of the survey to collect more questionnaires in some countries in order to obtain more meaningful results.

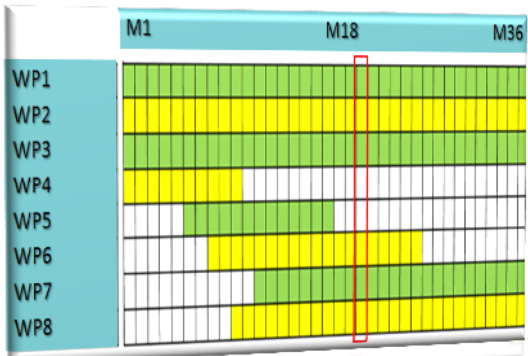
